To our members, friends, and families:

The Board of Directors of the Historical Vintage Car Club of Delaware have been watching the COVID-19 situation as closely as all of you. Our immediate priority is the safety and well being of our members, our partners, and their families. We wanted you to know that we share your concerns, and that we have made the following decisions regarding the 2020 season so far.

In order to promote social distancing, and in accordance with the CDC's recommendation of limiting gatherings of more than 50 people, all membership meetings that are typically held at the Milford Bowling Lanes on the second Tuesday of each month have been cancelled until further notice. Milford Bowling Lanes has also ceased operations as part of the national effort to slow the spread of the virus.

The Board of Directors remains committed to the efficient operation of the Club. However, due to the restrictions placed on restaurants in the area, the Board will not meet in person as scheduled until further notice. Club business will still be conducted through electronic means (email, phone, etc.). The Board will continue to keep the membership updated through electronic means via email, Facebook, and the website. When necessary, official correspondence may be sent via USPS to the entire membership.

The Spring Car Show at Del-Tech Owens Campus scheduled for April 18, 2020 has been cancelled. As of now, this show is not due to be rescheduled, as Del-Tech has suspended all activities on their campuses until further notice.

Cruise nights at Wayback Burgers scheduled for March 27, 2020 and April 24, 2020 have been cancelled. A determination will be made for later scheduled dates as the situation continues to progress.


